Cherry, Grape and Small Salad Tomatoes

| Name | Type/Shape | Color | Size | D/I | # days | Comments |

| Black Cherry | Cherry | Brownish red | Small | Indeterminate | 75 | Great color and sweet juicy flavor. Heavy bearer. |
| Grape | Grape | Red | Small oval | Indeterminate | 60 | Very sweet, complex flavor is delicious and a favorite everywhere |
| Jaune Flammee | Large cherry | Golden-yellow skins and flesh | Small/2-3 ounce fruits | Indeterminate | 75 | French heirloom variety, tangy taste and beautiful color, a great addition to salads, salsa |
| Juliet (Hybrid) | Grape | Red | Large | Indeterminate | 60 | Long, beautiful clusters with incredible yields. Full tomato flavor is high in both acid and sugar. |
| Lemon Drop | Cherry | Yellow | Small | Indeterminate | 80 | Tart & sweet translucent yellow-green fruits |
| Matt's Wild Cherry | Cherry | Red | Small (almost currant) | Indeterminate | 60 | Super flavor! Fruits in bunches. Kids love them. Be ready pick lots of fruit! |
| Pink Bumble Bee | Cherry | Red with gold stripes | Small | Indeterminate | 65 | Remarkable red with gold color and great sweet flavor, will produce all season. |
| Purple Bumble Bee | Cherry | Green & purple striped | Small | Indeterminate | 65 | Extraordinary striped colors matched by sweet juicy flavor. A must for your salads and snacks. |
| Sprite | Grape | Red | Small | Determinate | 60 | Compact, determinate variety for sweet grape tomatoes. Ideal for patio or container growing. |
| Sungold Cherry (Hybrid) | Cherry | Orange | Small | Indeterminate | 57 | Earliest and sweetest cherry. Best eaten fresh from the vines, or in salads-if you don't eat them all first |
| Sunrise Bumble Bee | Cherry | Yellow with red stripes | Small | Indeterminate | 65 | Flesh has pink marbling. Flavor is sweet and juicy. Adds great color and flavor to any dish. |
| Super Sweet 100 (Hybrid) | Cherry | Red | Small | Indeterminate | 78 | Robust prolific plants with good disease resistance bearing clusters of 1" sweet fruits |
| Sweet Gold (Hybrid) | Cherry | Yellow orange | Small | Indeterminate | 60 | Early sweet cherry rivals Sun Gold with more resistance to splitting. |
| Tumbling Tom | Cherry | Red | Small 1-2 inches | Determinate | 70 | Cascading vines make this a perfect choice for hanging basket or patio planter |
| Yellow Pear | Mini-pear | Yellow | Small 1 ½ inches | Indeterminate | 75 | Yellow mini-pear fruits for fresh eating and salads. Bright color, firm texture. |

| <i>Amish Paste</i> | Oxheart | Red | Medium/ 8 ounce fruits | Indeterminate | 85 | The ultimate sauce tomato, prolific producer, balanced sweet/acid flavor |
| <i>Opalka Paste</i> | Plum (square-ish) | Red | Medium/5"x3" | Indeterminate | 82 | Polish heirloom variety produces bounty of meaty fruits with few seeds and super taste |
| <i>San Marzano</i> | Plum (square-ish) | Red | Medium | Indeterminate | 80 | Italian flavor sensation for all cooking uses: paste, sauce, soups. Holds well on vine or in storage |
| <i>Speckled Roman</i> | Elongate | Red with orange and yellow stripes | Medium/ 3" wide, 5" long | Indeterminate | 85 | Beautiful color, meaty flavor, great fresh or cooked |

| <i>Principe Borghese</i> | Mini-plum | Red | Small | Determinate | 75 | Traditional Italian heirloom variety for sun-drying. Has few seeds and little juice but packed with flavor. Great for salads or stir-fry too. |

Tomatillo (*Physalis ixocarpa*)

| <i>Toma Verde Tomatillo</i> | Tomatillo | Green/gold with papery husk | Small | | 77 | Most commonly used in salsa, ripe when paper husk splits. Also eaten fresh when fully ripened to yellow. Nutty, tangy taste |
| <i>Purple Tomatillo</i> | Tomatillo | Dark purple with papery husk | Small | | 80 | Dark rich color with slightly sweeter flavor than green tomatillos |

Ground Cherry (*Physalis pruinosa, physalis peruviana*)

| Berkeley Tie Dye (Pink) | Beefsteak | Dark pink with green stripes | Medium-large/ 8-12 ounce | Indeterminate | 70 | Meaty beefsteak with rich, balanced sweet and acid flavors. |
| Black Krim | Russian globe shape | Purple skin Red flesh | Medium / 4- 6 inch fruits | Indeterminate | 80 | Fabulous rich flavor for eating, slicing, salads, salsa |
| Brandywine (red) | Beefsteak | Red | Large/ up to 16 ounce fruits | Indeterminate | 82 | Most well known heirloom, introduced in 1889, excellent for slicing and eating fresh |
| Brandywine - Black | Beefsteak | Dark purple-brown | Large/ up to 16 ounce fruits | Indeterminate | 82 | 1920s variety saved by local Pennsylvania seedsman. Deep earthy, sweet flavor and rich color |
| Brandywine - Yellow | Beefsteak | Yellow | Large/ up to 16 ounce fruits | Indeterminate | 82 | Yellow variety of classic Brandywine, known for outstanding creamy texture, rich tangy flavor. |
| Carbon | Flattened globe | Dark purple skin, Brick red flesh | Medium large/8-12 ounces | Indeterminate | 80 | One of the best tasting tomatoes of any kind, exceptionally rich yet sweet |
| Carmello (hybrid) | Globe | Red | Medium 10-12 ounces | Indeterminate | 75 | Classic French slicing tomato with high yield, great juicy round fruits and some disease resistance |
| Celebrity (hybrid) | Globe | Red | 8-10 ounces | Determinate | 70 | Great producer of clusters of firm, flavorful, tasty red fruit. Disease resistant |
| Chef's Choice Orange | Beefsteak | Orange | 8-12ounces | Indeterminate | 75 | Rich orange color, low-acid large fruits with great texture and flavor that earned the name. |
| Cherokee Green | Beefsteak | Green | Medium large/ 8-10 ounces | Indeterminate | 72 | A variant from Cherokee Purple that bears bright green fruits with some yellow-orange on the blossom end when ripe. Bold, complex flavor. |
| Cherokee Purple | Beefsteak | Chocolate | 10-16 ounces | Indeterminate | 75 | Excellent flavor, very productive, large harvests |
| Cosmonaut Volkov | Flattened globe | Red | Medium large/8-12 ounces | Indeterminate | 65 | Reliable early producer of juicy, rich-tasting fruits. Heirloom from Ukraine, tolerates colder summers. |
| Early Wonder | Globe | Red | Medium/6 ounces | Determinate | 55 | Compact and early maturing variety with great taste...a true wonder! |
| Fourth of July (Hybrid) | Round | Red | Medium small/ 2 ½ inches | Indeterminate | 50 | Extra early fruiting makes this an early summer favorite. Juicy, firm slicing tomatoes in clusters. |
| Garden Peach | Round | Light yellow skin | Medium small /3-4 | Indeterminate | 71 | Early ripening, very sweet and mild with a little |

| Gregori's Altai | Beefsteak | Pink-Red | Large 8-12 ounces | Indeterminate | 67 | Native of Siberia producing large fruits with balanced sweetness/acidity over a long season. |
| Indigo Blue Beauty | Globe | Red with blue shoulders | Medium 6-8 ounces | Indeterminate | 80 | Large fruits loaded with anti-oxidants linked to the dark color. Heavy producer of meaty fruits. |
| Jet Star | Globe | Red | Medium 7-8 ounces | Compact Indeterminate | 72 | High yields of blemish-free smooth and firm red fruits. A best-seller since Harris introduced in 1979 |
| Kellogg's Breakfast | Beefsteak | Orange | Very large/ 1-2 pound | Indeterminate | 85 | Huge orange beefsteaks with bright orange color. Juicy and meaty with rich flavor. |
| Legend | Globe | Red | Medium/ 7-8 ounce | Determinate | 68 | Early producer of glossy red, round fruits. Produce well in cooler temperatures and resists late blight. |
| Mexico | Beefsteak | Dark pink | Large/16 ounces | Indeterminate | 80 | Family heirloom brought from Mexico, heavy bearers of large flavorful round fruit |
| Mortgage Lifter | Beefsteak | Red | Large/ 10-14 ounce | Indeterminate | 80 | Productive plants bearing excellent large red beefsteak tomatoes |
| Moskvich | Globe | Red | Medium small/ 4-6 ounces | Indeterminate | 60 | Early ripening, tolerates colder weather but yields surprisingly rich-tasting deep red fruits. |
| Mountain Merit (hybrid) | Globe | Red | Medium/ 8-12 ounces | Determinate | 75 | Prize-winning disease-resistant reliable producer of medium slicing tomatoes. Great for limited space |
| Paul Robeson | Beefsteak | Dark maroon skin, dark red flesh | Medium | Indeterminate | 75 | One of the favorites of black tomato lovers for its crack-free fruits & classic rich, complex flavor. |
| Pineapple | Beefsteak | Bi-colored red and yellow | Large/1-2 pounds | Indeterminate | 85 | Large bright yellow fruits with swirls and streaks of red inside and out. Rich fruity flavor. |
| Pruden's Purple | Beefsteak | Pinkish red | Large 10-12 ounces | Indeterminate | 72 | Earlier producing classic pinkish red heirloom that rivals any for balanced tart/sweet flavor and smooth texture with few seeds. |

| Sioux | Globe | Red | Medium 6 ounces | Indeterminate | 70 | Steady producer of excellent tasting classic tomatoes. Variety released by U of Nebraska/ |
| Tasmanian Chocolate | Globe | Burgundy red | 4-6 ounces | Determinate | 75 | Luscious dark red flesh delivers rich heirloom flavor on compact bushy plants suitable for container growing. |
| Taxi | Globe | Yellow | 4-6 ounce | Compact Indeterminate | 64 | Smooth, blemish free, attractive, sweet-flavored and easy to grow. Concentrated early set. |
| Valencia | Globe | Orange | Medium 8-10 ounces | Indeterminate | 76 | Vibrant sunny orange color and meaty texture of these medium sized round fruits makes them a winner for slicing, salads or salsa. Few seeds. |
| Woodle Orange | Globe | Orange | Large 10-12 ounces | Indeterminate | 75 | Vibrant tangerine colored skin and flesh makes this as tasty to the eyes as it is to the taste buds. Smooth round fruits and complex sweet flavor. |
